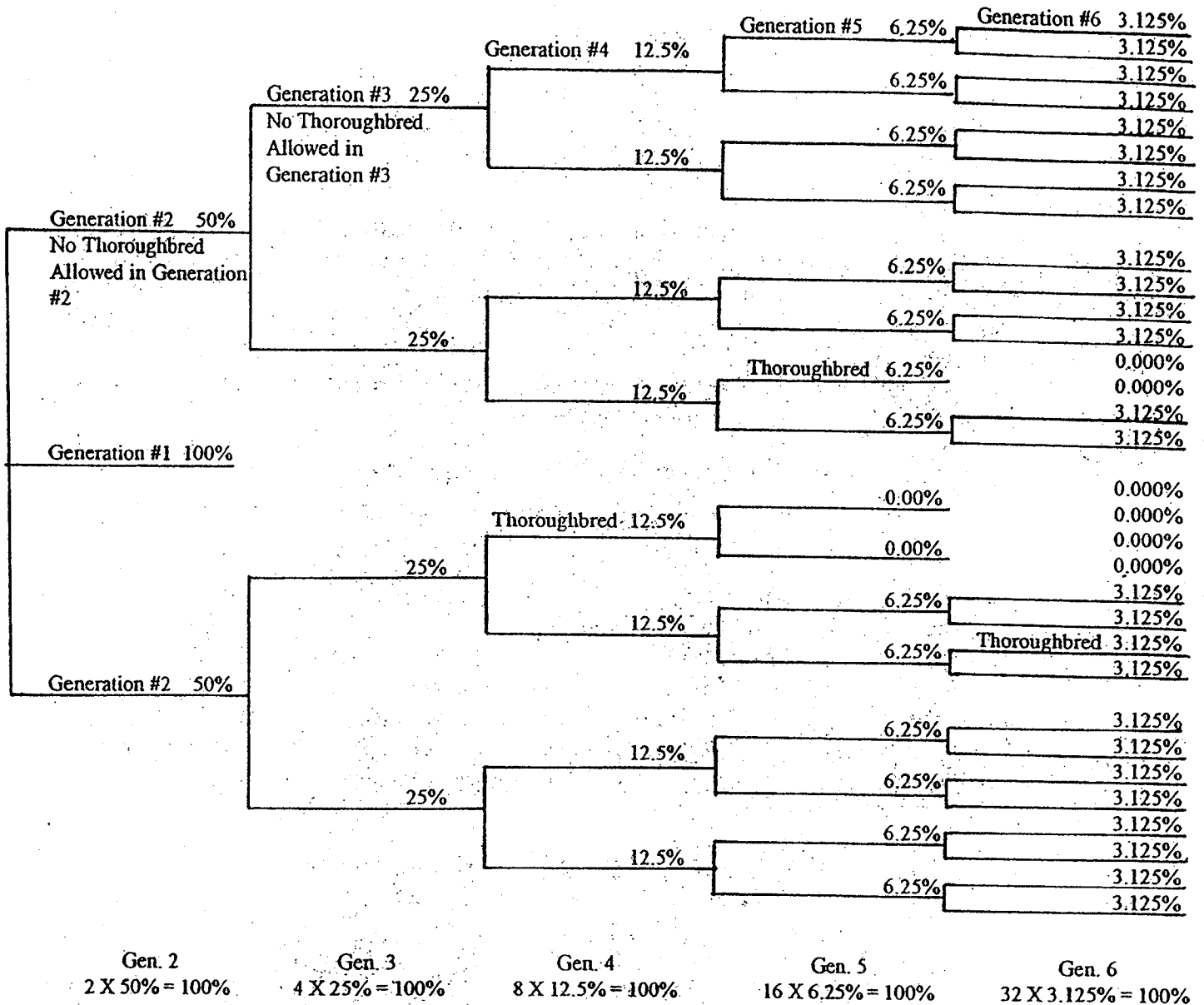


PEDIGREE EXAMPLE



1. To be eligible for registration, a horse cannot carry more than 25% Thoroughbred blood.
2. No registered Thoroughbred is allowed in the 2nd. or 3rd. generations.
3. The WFQHA recognizes the first 27,000 horses listed by the A.Q.H.A. for registry as Foundation blood. (75%) of the pedigree must descend from, or run to Foundation blood.
4. The horse in the above example is 21.875% Thoroughbred, and is eligible for registration, assuming that no additional Thoroughbred appears on the other lines in the pedigree that would cause the Thoroughbred blood to exceed 25%.
5. Example horse: $12.5\% + 6.25\% + 3.125\% = 21.875\%$ Thoroughbred blood.
