Cattle Fees: AQHA&Open Cutting=\$35, Ranch Cutting=\$25, Working Cow Horse=\$25, Roping Classes \$20/go

Stalls: Box Stall=\$35 Tie Stalls (June & July show only) \$20. No overnight tying to trailers allowed at Heartland Stables. Stalls are first come first serve.

Camping: \$10/night, limited availability. NO HORSES ALLOWED IN CAMPSITES AT HEARTLAND STABLES.
